Hope this finds you all safe and well after a relaxing Christmas with family and friends.

What a year 2020 was! Happy New Year for 2021.

ACDC invites Auburn community members to Centenary Park for Australia Day Breakfast. The format of the morning will be similar to past events, but with a few changes to accommodate COVID-19 requirements. Cooked food and fruit will be available from the Pavilion. Cold Drinks will not be sold this year. Tea and coffee will be available. **The Flag Raising Ceremony** will commence the mornings activities, and there will be live music.

Social distancing and hygiene procedures will be in operation. To assist with our COVID plan, we request that all patrons, where possible, **bring their own plates, cutlery, mugs, chairs and drinks.** A cooked breakfast can be purchased for \$5 with children under 12yrs free.

Entry to the Park will be from two points...pedestrian gate in Church Street (just down from the Chemist) and the Memorial Gates in King Street (opposite the Auburn Institute). Tables will be set up with the sign-in paperwork, and hand sanitiser. A *QR check-in* system will be in operation, as well as manual sign-in sheets for anyone without a mobile phone *or QR app*.

Families and friends are asked to sit and relax in their groups, while also keeping some distance from the next group.

We are also asking families to bring along their own **cutlery, plates and cups/mugs**, to reduce the use of single-use plastics.

To assist with the organisation of the event, you can pre-register your intention to attend our Australia Day Breakfast.
