ACDC - December Report

<u>Street Library:</u> A *Little Street Library* ('box on a post') was offered to ACDC earlier this year. Local artists are working to decorate the Library box and a location for its installation will soon be finalised.

Centenary Parl Liahtina: ACDC. in partnership with Auburn Business and Tourism Association (ABTA), has been investigating more permanent lighting fixtures in Centenary Park, to be utilised at Christmas time and for other special occasions. We agreed further this project to February/March in readiness for the 2024 season.

<u>Subcommittee Guidelines:</u> ACDC has been collaborating with the Auburn Institute Management Committee (AIMC) to finalise operational *Terms of Reference* for the Auburn Institute. *Terms of Reference* is a document now in place for each subcommittee of ACDC, which provide guiding principles and operational processes for the subcommittees.



Auburn's History Column:

RSL Memorabilia continued

After having 50 years as a club room, it is understandable that the items housed there would bring back memories and one of these was the holding of indoor bowls competitions, the hall being the right length for the bowling carpet.

During the year 1974 the "Northern Argus" reported the weekly scores of the Clare and District Indoor Bowls Association competing teams, with the Auburn Red team the 1974 Pennant Winners after a close match. This was the first time the shield had been won by an Auburn team. The Grand Final was held in the Clare Postal Institute Clubrooms. The Association President (Mr K. Trewartha) presented the Shield and Pennant to the two skippers of the Auburn Team – Arthur Kench and Malcolm Garrard.

Two honour boards of the Auburn team over the years plus a framed photo of the wining team in 1974, had been proudly displayed on the RSL clubroom walls. However, they had all become very dilapidated.

Janet and Doug Kench restored the picture frame and recorded all the information from the honour boards to be effectively displayed with the 1974 photo of the winning Auburn team.

In more recent times it was hard to get a team and some men would sometimes fill in for the ladies in the morning and ladies sometimes helped the men out at night. The teams eventually went into recess and the Indoor Bowls mats were taken to the Auburn institute.


